Probabilities in terms of holding the courses online in the academic year 2020-2021 / COVID-19 pandemic situation *** This plan will be effective only in case visa applications are not going to be resumed! ***

Dear Applicants,

Duna International College (DIC) - Budapest has adopted crucial prevention measures in order to protect its students and staff from the very first days of **COVID-19** outbreak in Hungary.

In order not to miss the time and supporting our students DIC has considered different possibilities for the academic year 2020-2021.

Hereby we would like to inform you about our online training plans and timelines for the next academic year (2020-2021) in the following details:

In case of not-resuming visa applications by August.20.2020:
 All DIC courses for the October & November intakes will be held online in the autumn semester of the academic year 2020-2021.

* In case of not-resuming visa applications by November.20.2020:

All DIC courses for October, November & Intensive intakes will be held online for the spring semester of the academic year 2020-2021.

Tuition fees & Refunding:

Type of the courses	Commences on:	Tuition fee + Application fee (Euro)	Comments:
Regular	October.05.2020	€6000	Can be paid in 2 installments in €3500+€2500 format.
November intake	November.10.2020	€6000	Can be paid in 2 installments in €3500+€2500 format.
Intensive	January.11.2021	€5800	Installment is not possible.

Refunding in case of holding the courses online:

Refunding for the first semester 2020-2021 academic year:

- By September.20.2020: Only 20% of the tuition fee will be deducted and the rest will be refundable.
- After September.20.2020: Tuition fee is not refundable.
- Refunding for the second semester 2020-2021 academic year:
 - By November.30.2020: Only 20% of the second semester tuition fee will be deducted and the rest will be refundable. The first semester tuition fee is not refundable as well.
 - After November.30.2020: Tuition fee is not refundable.

Remarks:

- Commencement of the courses will follow the regular academic calendar of the College without any change.
- Payment of the tuition fee in 2 installments means paying of each installment before the commencement of the semester.
- In case of resuming visa applications students can apply for their visa and study permit through Hungarian Consulates as usual *after paying:*
 - 1. The rest of the tuition fee in case of paying in installments
 - 2. Accommodation fee
 - 3. Health insurance fee
 - Approval or rejection of the visa application will all depends on the Hungarian consulate and visa authorities' decision.
- Online courses include online teaching and seminars, online access to DIC booklets and online testing.
- All the above refunding options are effective even in case of resuming visa applications.
